Learn About Golden's History

Start your adventure by learning about the origins of our small mountain town at the Golden Museum. Located one block off Main Street, the Golden Museum features the history of the CPR, the historic Swiss Guides and their families. Take a walk back to the early days of the area when David Thompson, a surveyor for the North West Company, arrived in the Columbia Valley to set up a trading post, where he could trade with the indigenous people and continue mapping the surrounding area. Learn how the Kicking Horse River got its name. Open Monday to Friday from 10am to 5pm, and with admission by donation, there is something for every member of your family at the Golden Museum.

Get Active

Activities to get you moving aren't just limited to the best outdoor trails or the raddest slopest on the hill. In town, there are plenty of recreational spaces to move around in! Located at 102-806 9th St N is the Dogtooth Climbing Gym, which opens at 4pm and offers a unique space for climbers of all levels. Rates and more information can be found at their website.
